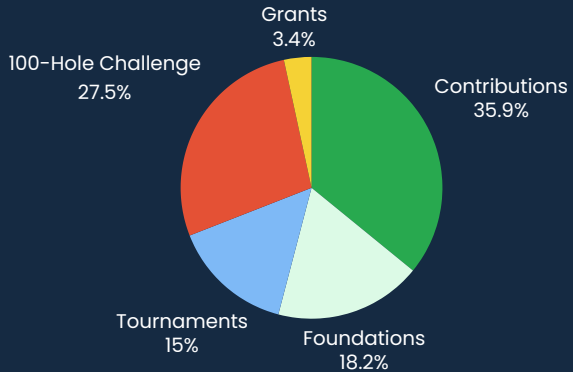
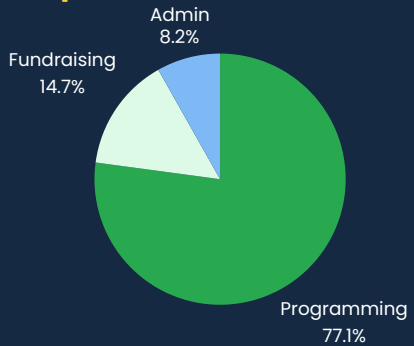

Our Staff and Coaches support 13 elementary school P.E. teachers to introduce the game of golf and our core values to over 7,000 students during physical education classes. Students are introduced to the sport of golf while learning basic golf motor skills and the inherent values of the game.



The game of golf for many students with special needs is an activity that helps develop their social skills, such as: taking turns, following directions, working together, and accepting change in their normal routine. Our programs help develop communication skills (vocabulary development, application of learned vocabulary, listening to and following multiple step directions).

Hudson started playing golf a little over a year ago and joined the First Tee Program at AllGolf (CB Smith Park) about the same time. Ever since, Hudson has been bitten by the golf bug!
